What you need for the lesson

Remember to have the following ready for your class:

- Lace Pillow
- 10 pairs of bobbins (20 individual bobbins)
- lacemaking / dressmaker pins
- scissors
- DMC coton perle #8 or equivalent thread

Anything I should know about printing the patten?

The pattern is formatted for A4. If you are using any other paper size then when you print, uncheck fit to paper so that the size of the pattern is not affected.
